BOATING SAFETY MATTERS

MINIMUM SAFETY EQUIPMENT NEEDED

- Personal flotation device fitted for each person on board or being towed, in addition to one throwable Type IV device
- Sound Producing Device
- Visual Distress Signal
- Fire Extinguisher
- Vessel Lights
- A current copy of your boat registration

It is also recommended to equip your vessel with an anchor and a sufficient amount of anchor line, a de-watering device and/or alternate means of propulsion in case your engine fails

PAY ATTENTION. WATCH YOUR SPEED. WEAR YOUR LIFE JACKET.

Remember, the best life jacket is the one you will wear!

The U.S. Coast Guard estimates that life jackets could have saved the lives of over 80% of boating fatality victims. Accidents happen very quickly on the water. As a boat operator, you are responsible for the safety of your passengers. Everyone on board should wear a life jacket all the time, while underway.

It is not "one size fits all". Child life jacket approvals are based on the child's weight. Check the "User Weight" on the label, or the approval statement that will read something like "Approved for use on recreational boats and uninspected commercial vessels not carrying passengers for hire, by persons weighing ___ lbs." They can be marked "less than 30", "30 to 50", "less than 50", or "50 to 90".

Certain life jackets are designed to keep your head above water and help you remain in a position which permits proper breathing.

To meet U.S. Coast Guard requirements, a boat must have a U.S. Coast Guard Approved life jacket for each person aboard. Boats 16 feet and over must have at least one Type IV throwable device as well.

All states have regulations regarding life jacket wear by children. Adult-sized life jackets will not work for children. Special life jackets are available. To work correctly, a life jacket must be worn, fit snugly, and not allow the child's chin or ears to slip through.

Life jackets should be tested for wear and buoyancy at least once each year. Waterlogged, faded, or leaky jackets should be discarded.

Life jackets must be properly stowed.
